Clean up thoroughly.

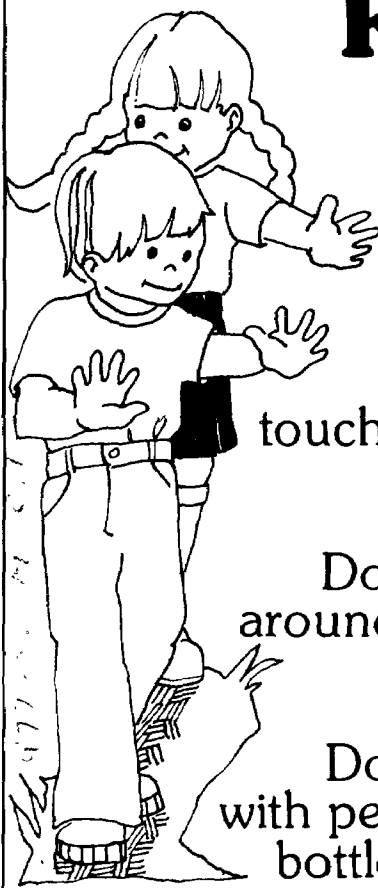
If you suspect that a person has been poisoned by a pesticide, get a doctor immediately and have the pesticide label available.

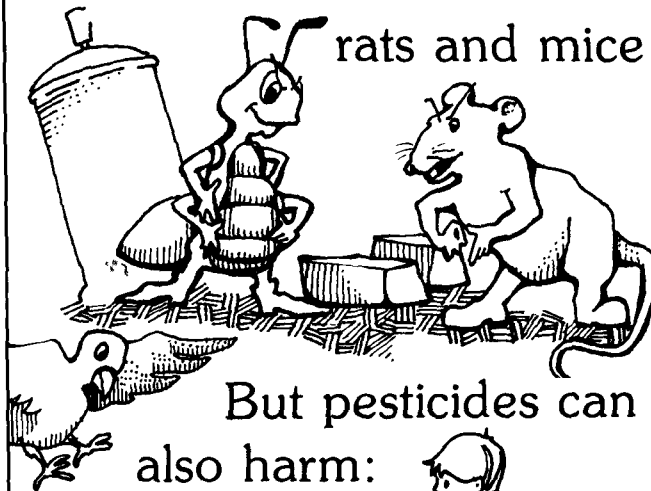
Don't play
