



# U.S. EPA Studies on Regional Remediation Markets

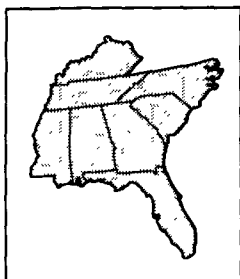

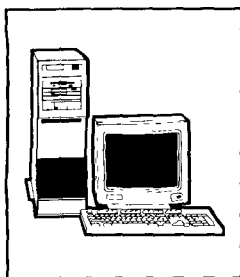
## ***Regional Market Opportunities for Innovative Site Cleanup Technologies: Middle Atlantic States***

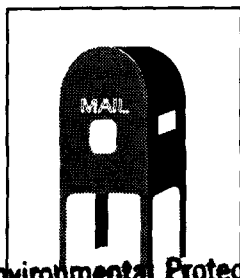

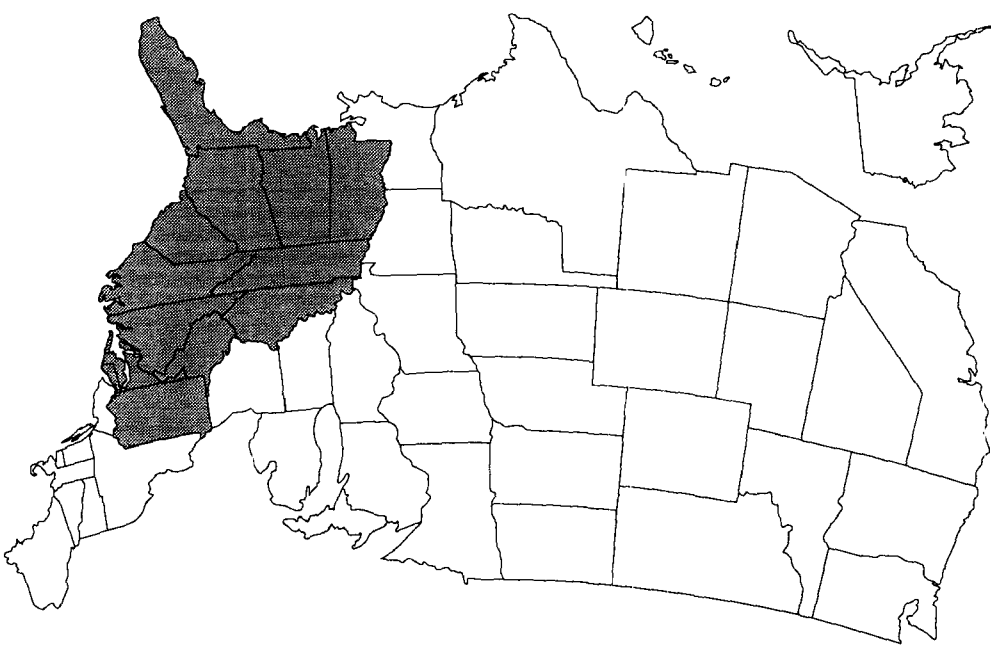
