FISCAL YEARS 1968--1978

This is a year-by-year listing of printed and audiovisual materials produced by the Federal solid waste management program since 1967. The original legislation for the solid waste program, the Solid Waste Disposal Act of 1965, directed the program to make available research results and other information pertaining to solid waste management. The program's current legislation, the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act of 1976, specifically directs EPA to "implement a program for the rapid dissemination of information on solid waste management," including the results of relevant research, surveys, and studies.

Among the 219 titles produced by the program in fiscal year 1978 are technical materials, journal articles, papers presented by Office of Solid Waste officials, reports to Congress, transcripts of public meetings and hearings, summaries of technical reports for the public, as well as audiovisual presentations, such as bumper stickers, posters, slide presentations, and radio/television public service announcements.

Beginning with fiscal year 1977, the list is presented in three sections. The first section includes all printed materials other than reports available from the National Technical Information Service and press releases, which are listed separately. The materials reflect the current concerns and activities of citizens and professionals in the fields of hazardous waste, resource recovery, and land disposal, that is, the development of the solid waste management field in general.

Copies of many of the items published since 1972 are available without charge from the Office of Solid Waste (write to Solid Waste Information, U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, Cincinnati, OH 45268). Other reports, mainly those emanating from EPA work carried out under contracts and grants, may be purchased from the National Technical Information Service, Springfield, VA 22161.

Many of the publications listed for earlier years are out of print and available only within the Agency or from government, university, or public libraries. Some of the out-of-print publications are available for reference in the Office of Solid Waste "open file," as are unpublished reports from grantees and contractors. A list of these open-file holdings is available upon request (from the Cincinnati address).
