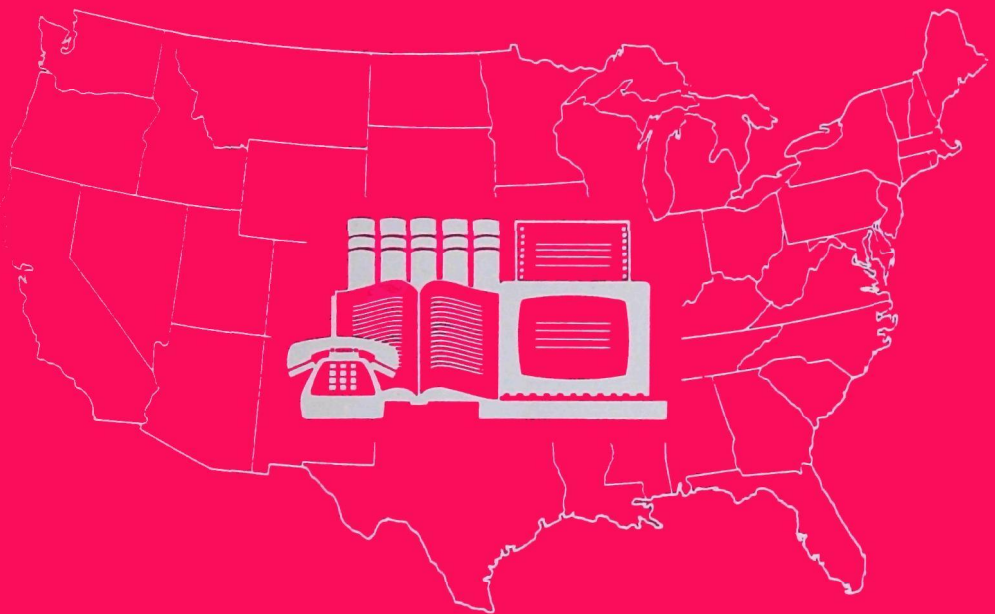

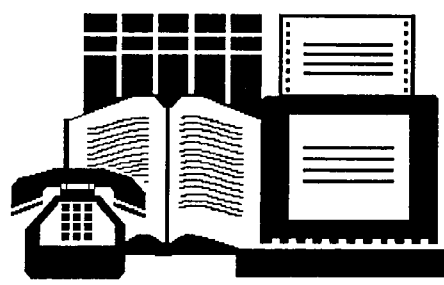

Only one-fifth of the collection is cataloged. The library offers a "periodical awareness service" to DEC employees where the tables of contents of magazines are copied and sent to anyone interested. The employees then ask for the articles to be sent to them via interlibrary loan (ILL).

While the DEC library is a branch of the Alaska State Library and open to the public, 95 percent of its circulation and ILL activity is for DEC and other State employees.
