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RECENT GRANT HIGHLIGHTS

GRANT AWARD DOLLARS FOR THE MONTH DECREASES

\$138.7 Million in grant awards (527) were approved in April compared to \$301.5 Million in grant applications (486) in March. State and local assistance including construction grants accounted for 426 or 81% total EPA Grants awarded in the month of April. WWT construction applications in process at the end of the month reached a record high of \$1.3 Billion.

41 WWT CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS AWARDED \$20 MILLION OR MORE

Forty-one of the 1226 active WWT construction projects funded under PL 92-500 have received EPA funding in excess of \$20 Million. (See page 6).

ACTIVE GRANT PROJECTS INCREASE BY 37% DURING FY 75

As of April 30, 1975, there were 6,832 active grant projects compared to 4,986 active grant projects as of the same month of 1974. Active WWT construction grant projects increased by 45% (1,716 projects). All other active state and local assistance and headquarter awarded projects increased by 11% during the current fiscal year.

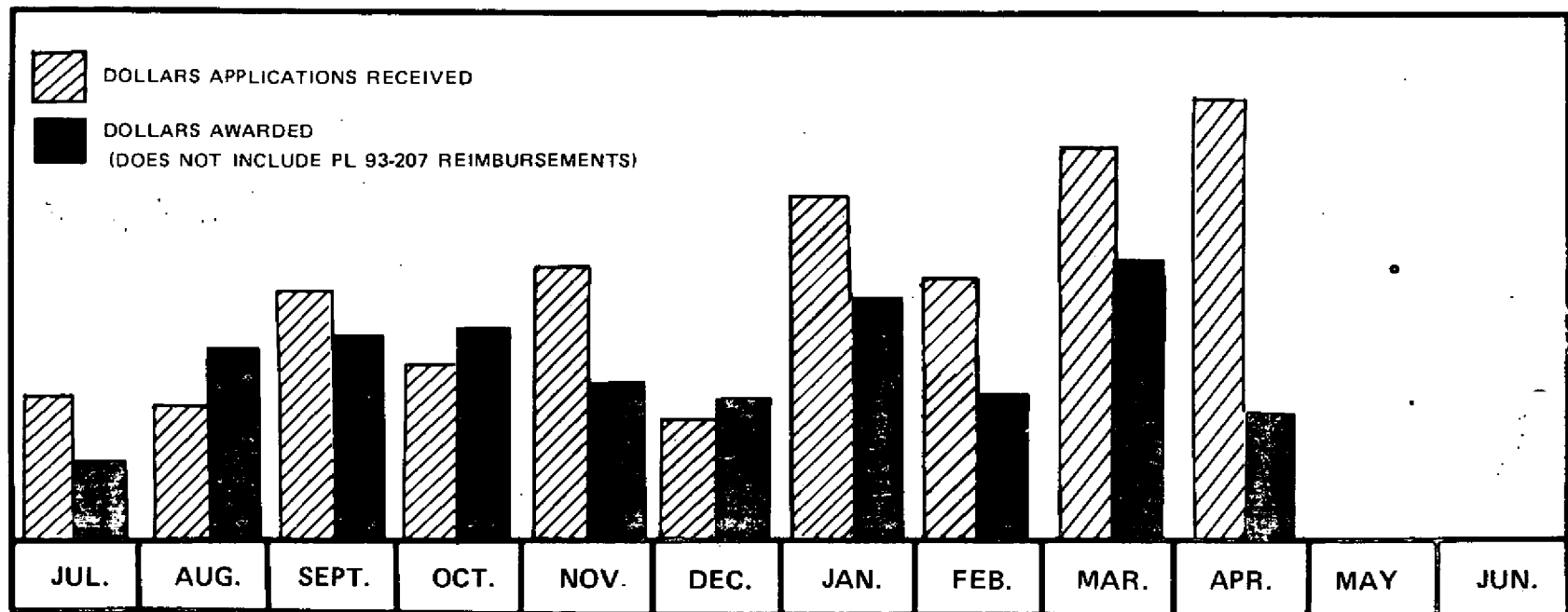

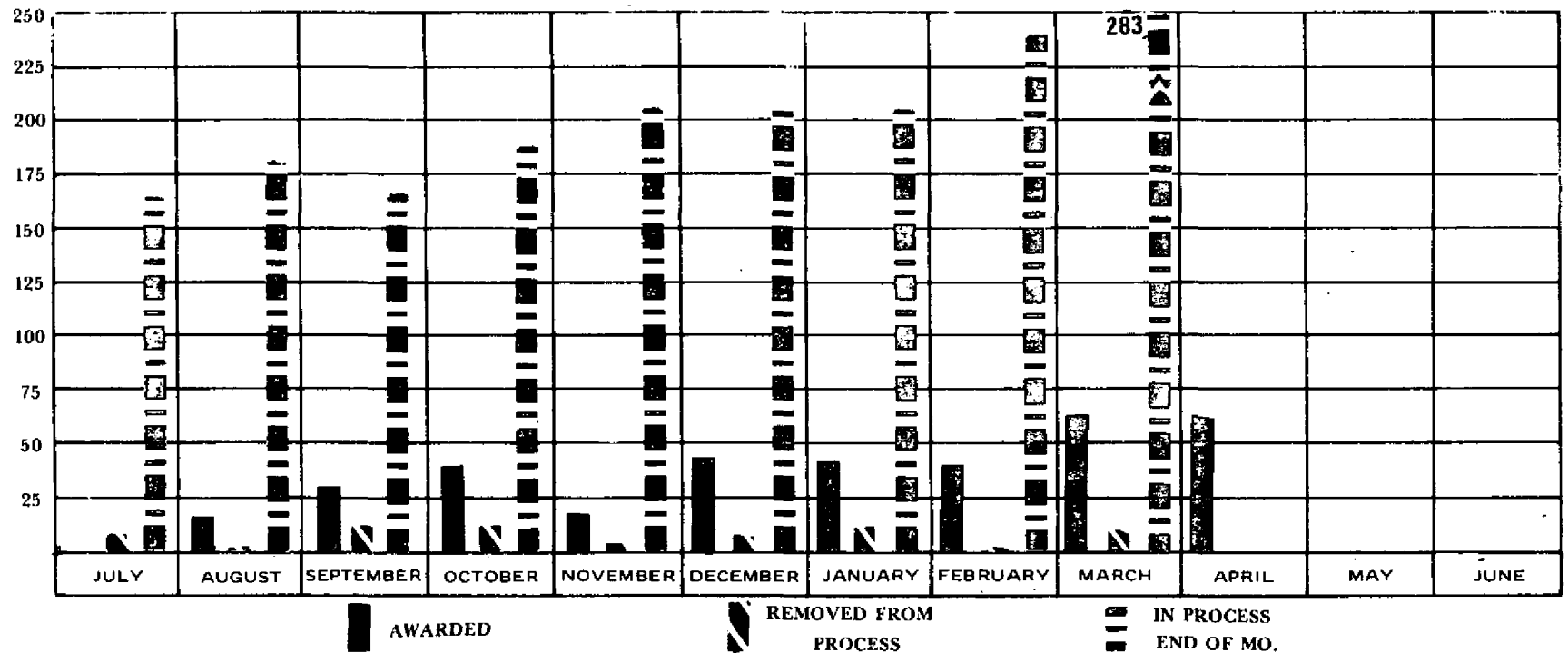

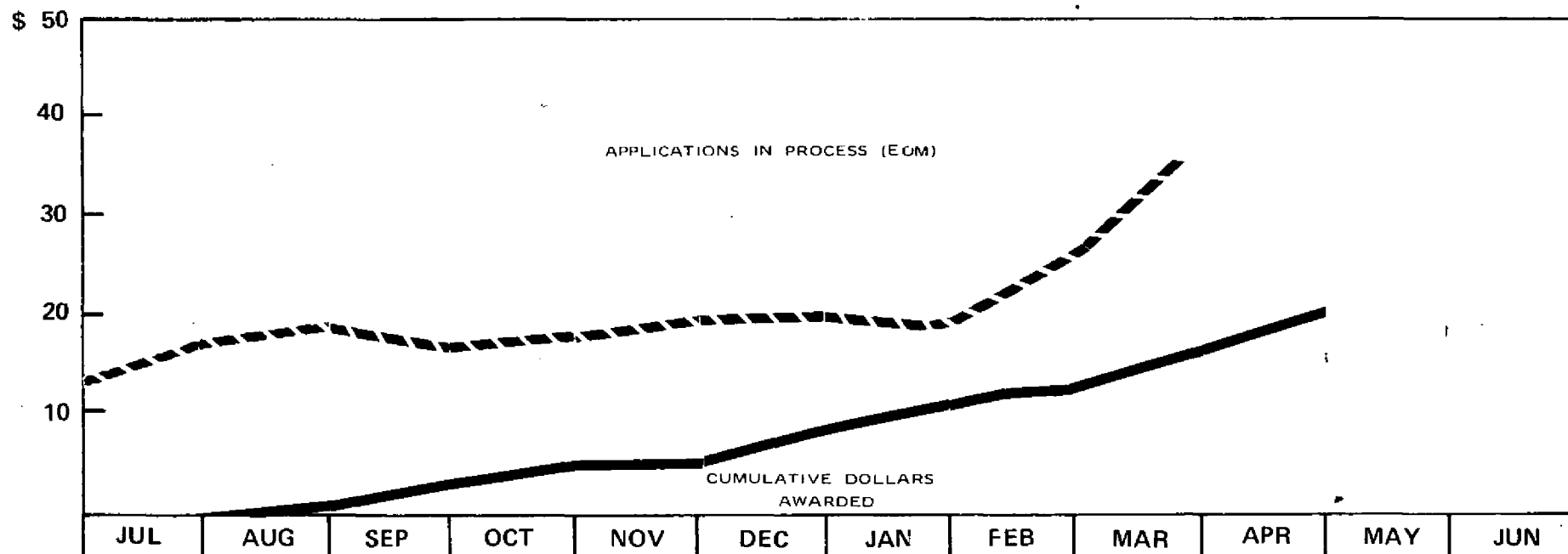

MILLIONS



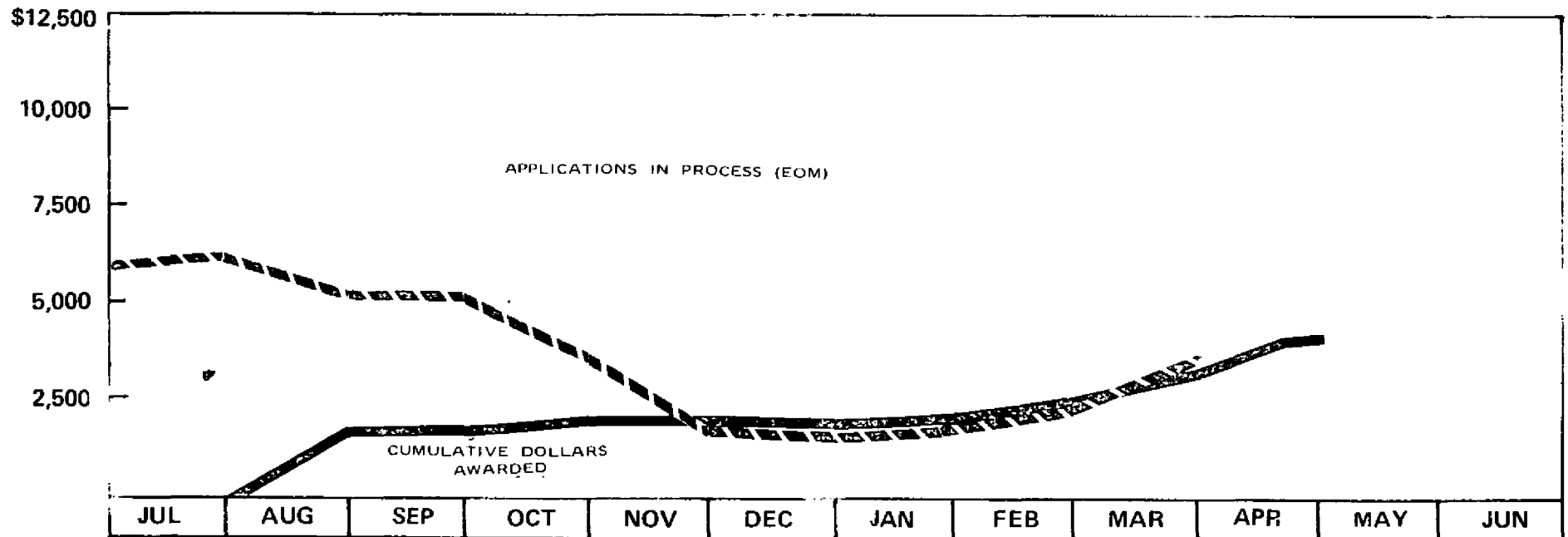
