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GRANT HIGHLIGHTS

EPA GRANT AWARD DOLLARS THROUGH DECEMBER UP 91% FROM LAST YEAR

EPA awarded \$896.0 million during the first three months of FY 80 compared to \$468.5 million during the same period of FY 79. The change (+91%) from the previous year is reflected by the increase in awards in the WWT Construction and Solid and Hazardous Waste Management grant programs.

RESEARCH, DEMONSTRATION AND OTHER HEADQUARTERS ACTIVE PROJECTS TOTAL \$191 MILLION

As of December 31, 1979, Headquarters active projects totaled \$191.0 million. Research grants represented 52% (\$98.6 million) of the total active grant dollars.

EPA ANNOUNCES CLEAN LAKES URBAN INITIATIVE GRANTS

EPA announced the award of grants to ten states to help cities study their urban lakes and develop procedures for improving water quality. The states and cities receiving assistance were as follow: Massachusetts (Arlington), New Jersey (Newark), Maryland (Baltimore), Florida (St. Petersburg), Wisconsin (Milwaukee), Arkansas (Pine Bluff), Missouri (St. Louis), Colorado (Denver), California (Oakland) and Washington (Seattle).

MAJORITY OF GRANTEEES RECEIVING WWT CONSTRUCTION GRANT FUNDS ARE SMALL

61% of the active projects and 16% of the grant funds awarded were for communities with census population of 10,000 or less. (pg.).

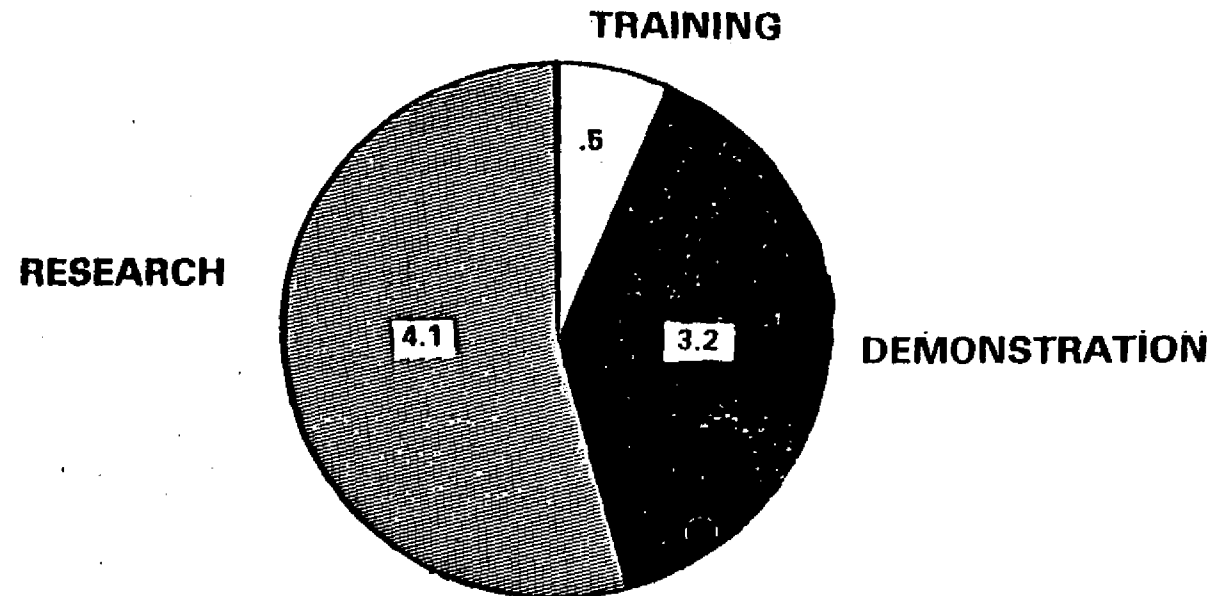
WWT CONSTRUCTION GRANT OUTLAYS TOTAL \$1.2 BILLION

EPA has paid \$1.2 billion for WWT construction grant projects during the first three months of FY 80. This includes \$20.9 million to reimbursable projects under PL 93-207. Outlays for the same period of FY 79 were \$.8 billion.

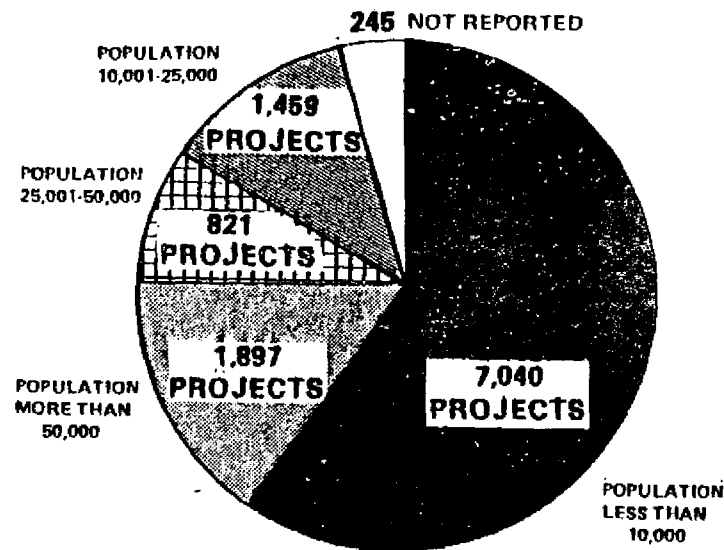
GRANT AWARD DOLLARS IN MILLIONS



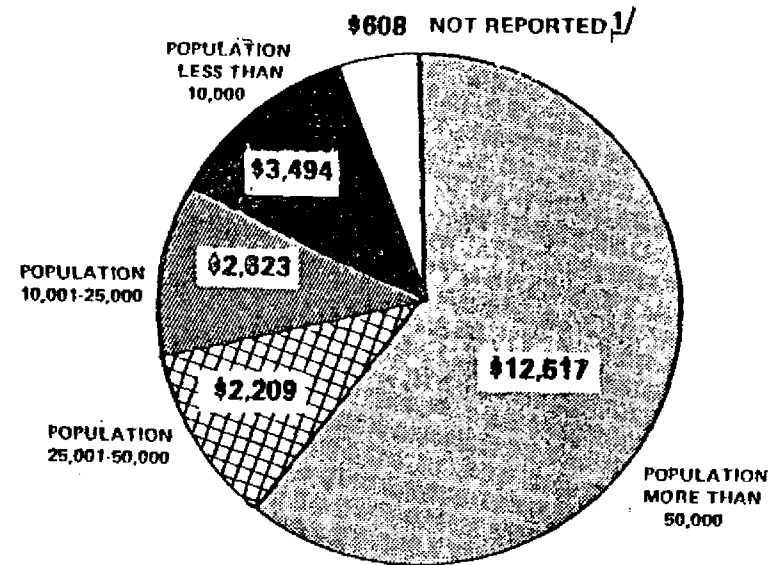

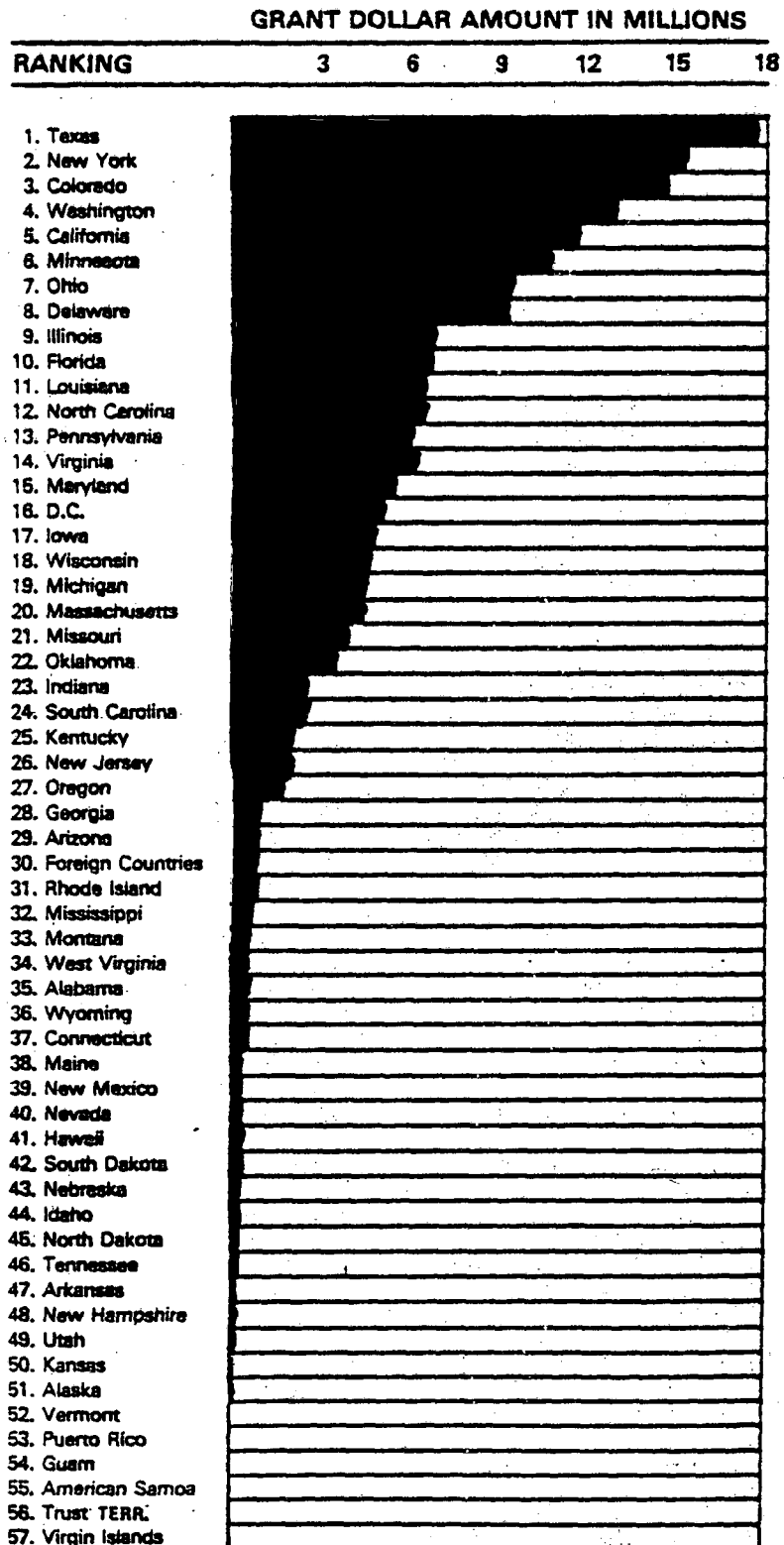

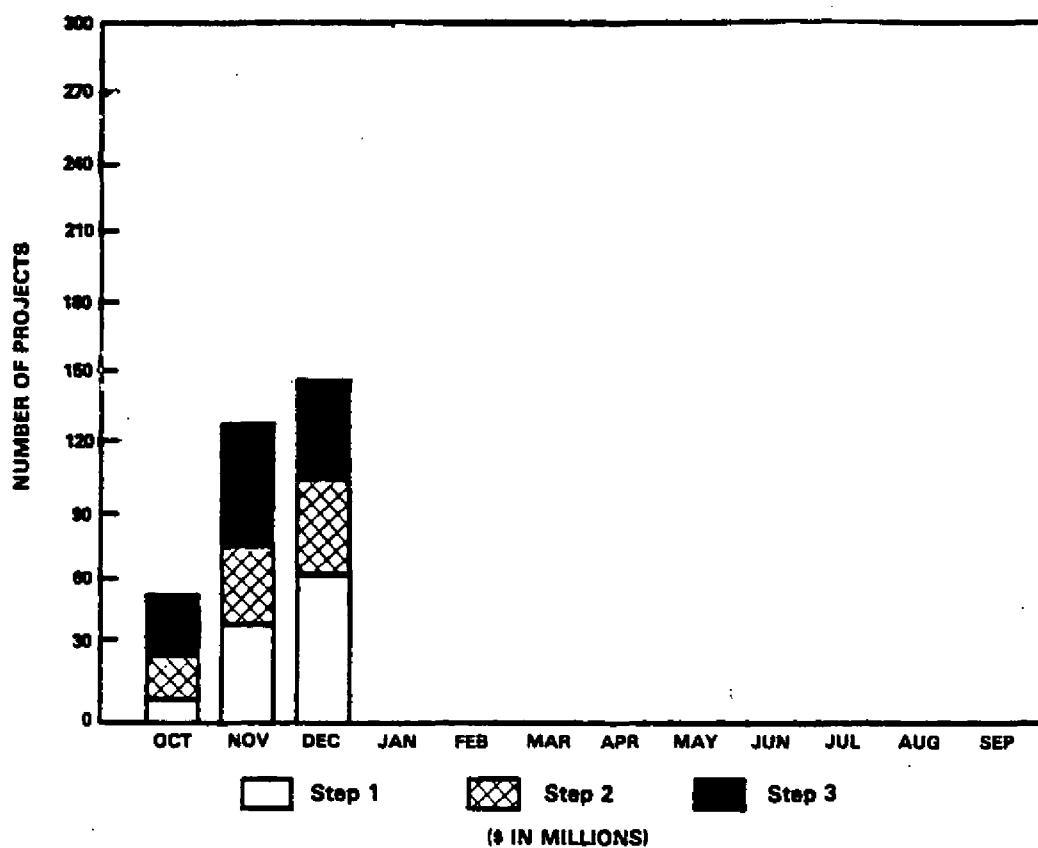

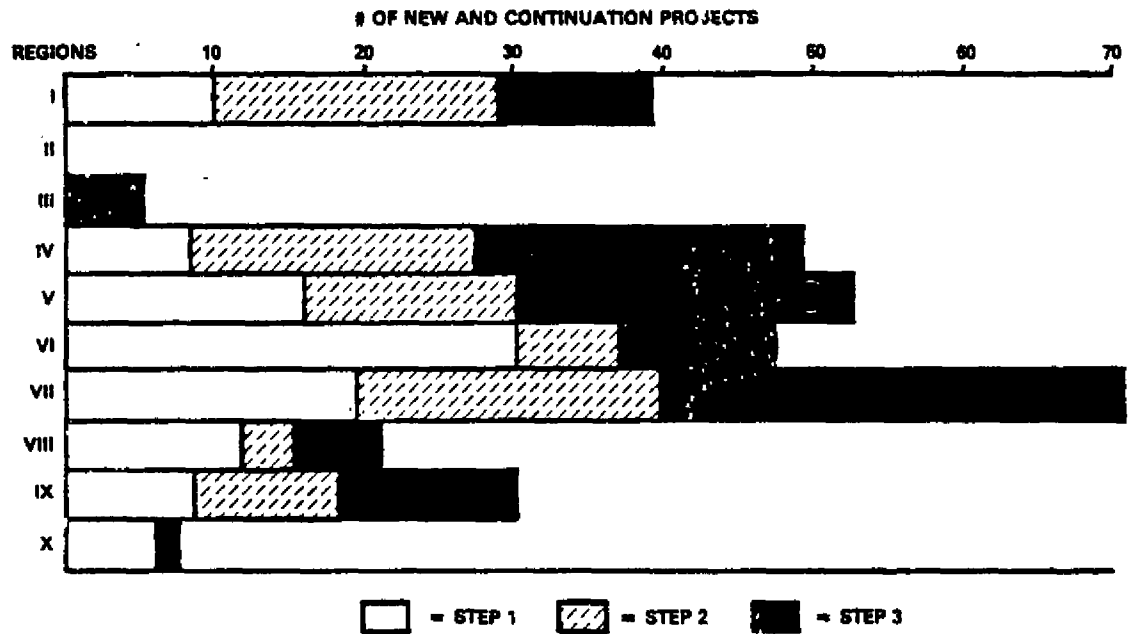
**WWT CONSTRUCTION GRANTS UNDER PL-92-500

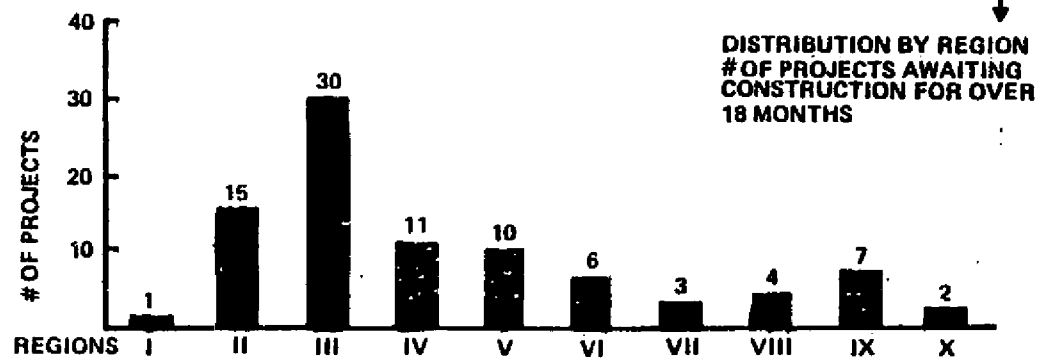
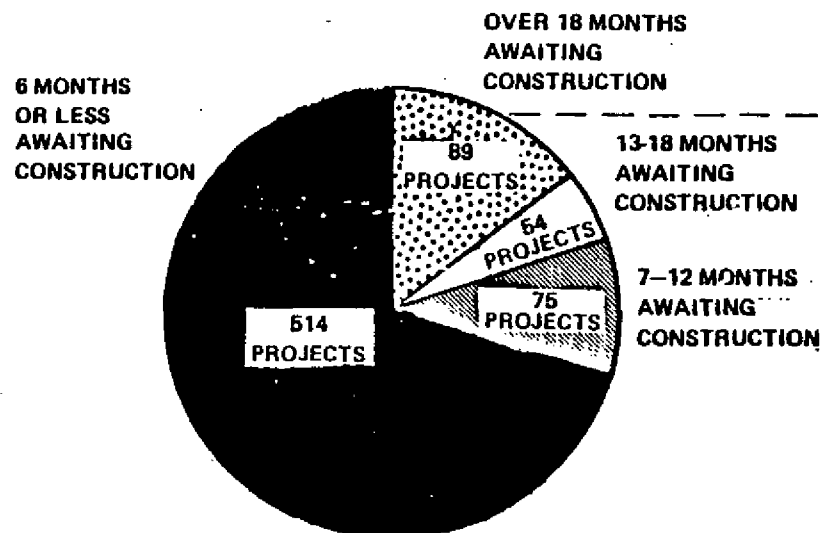

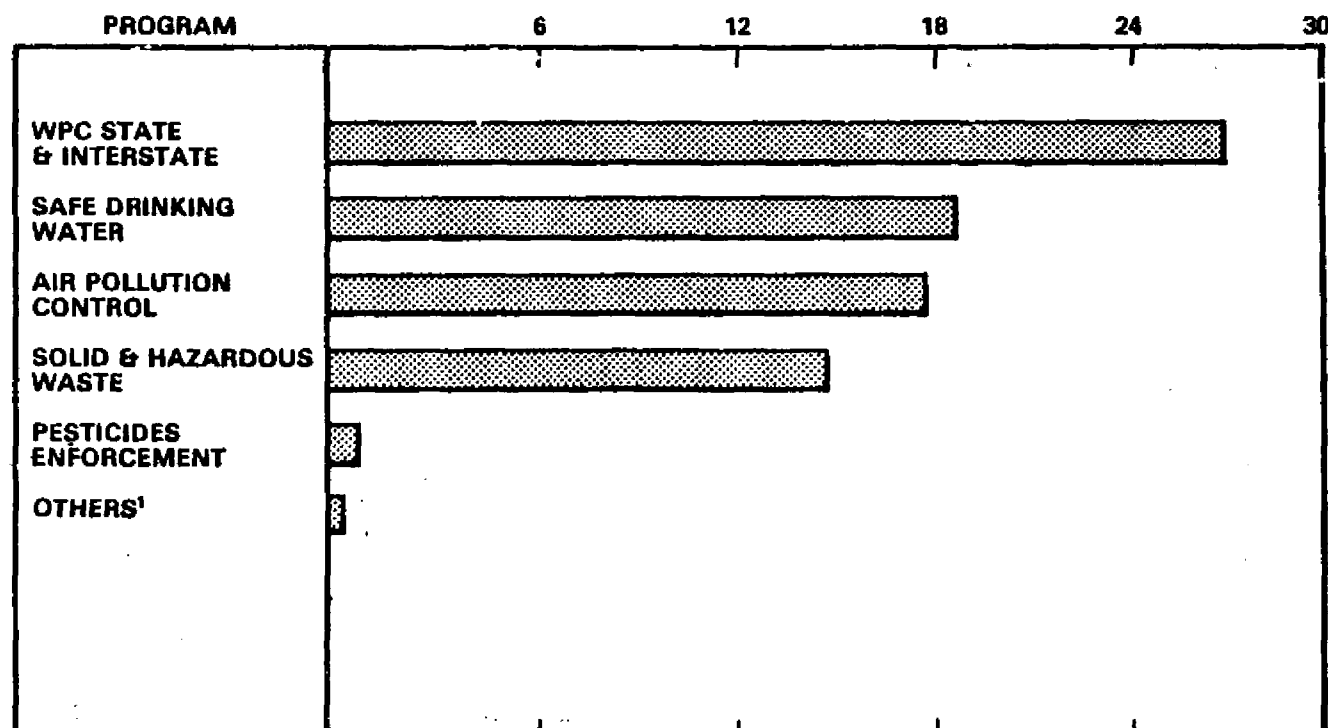

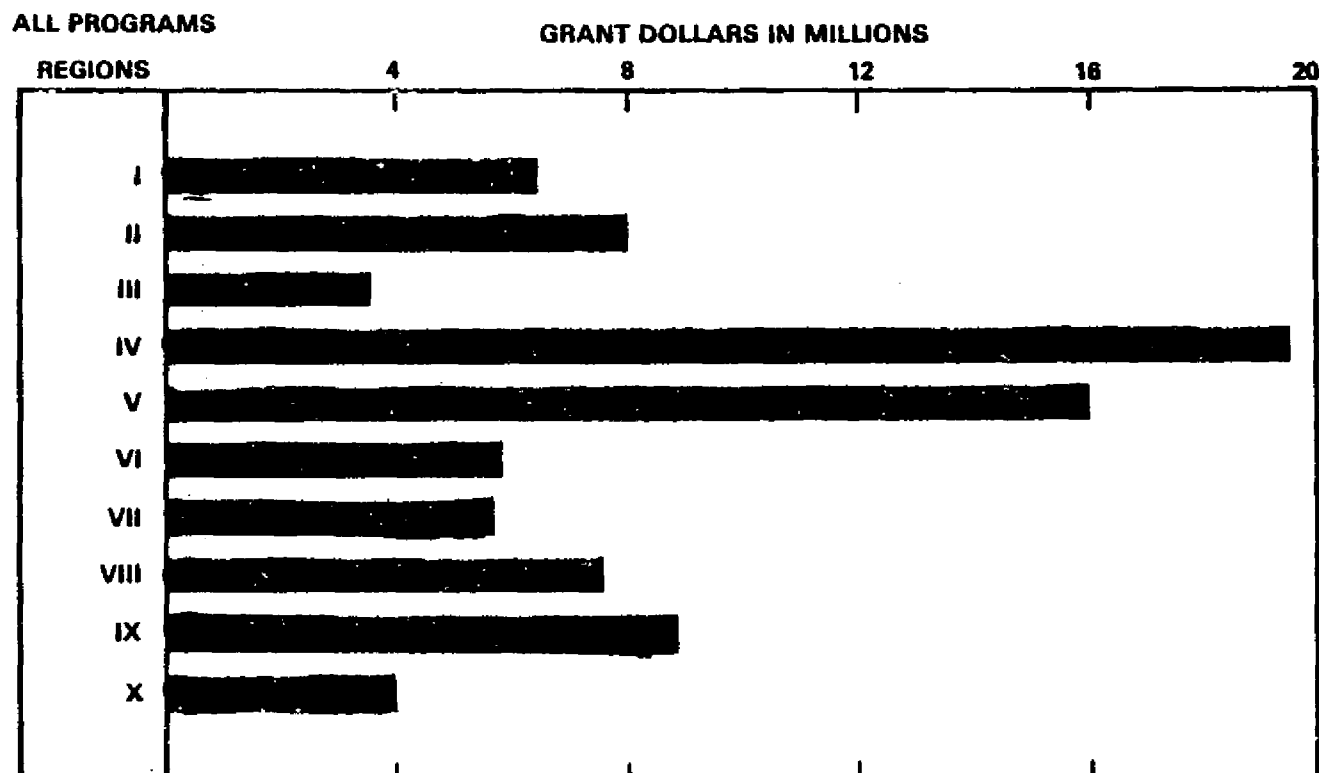
