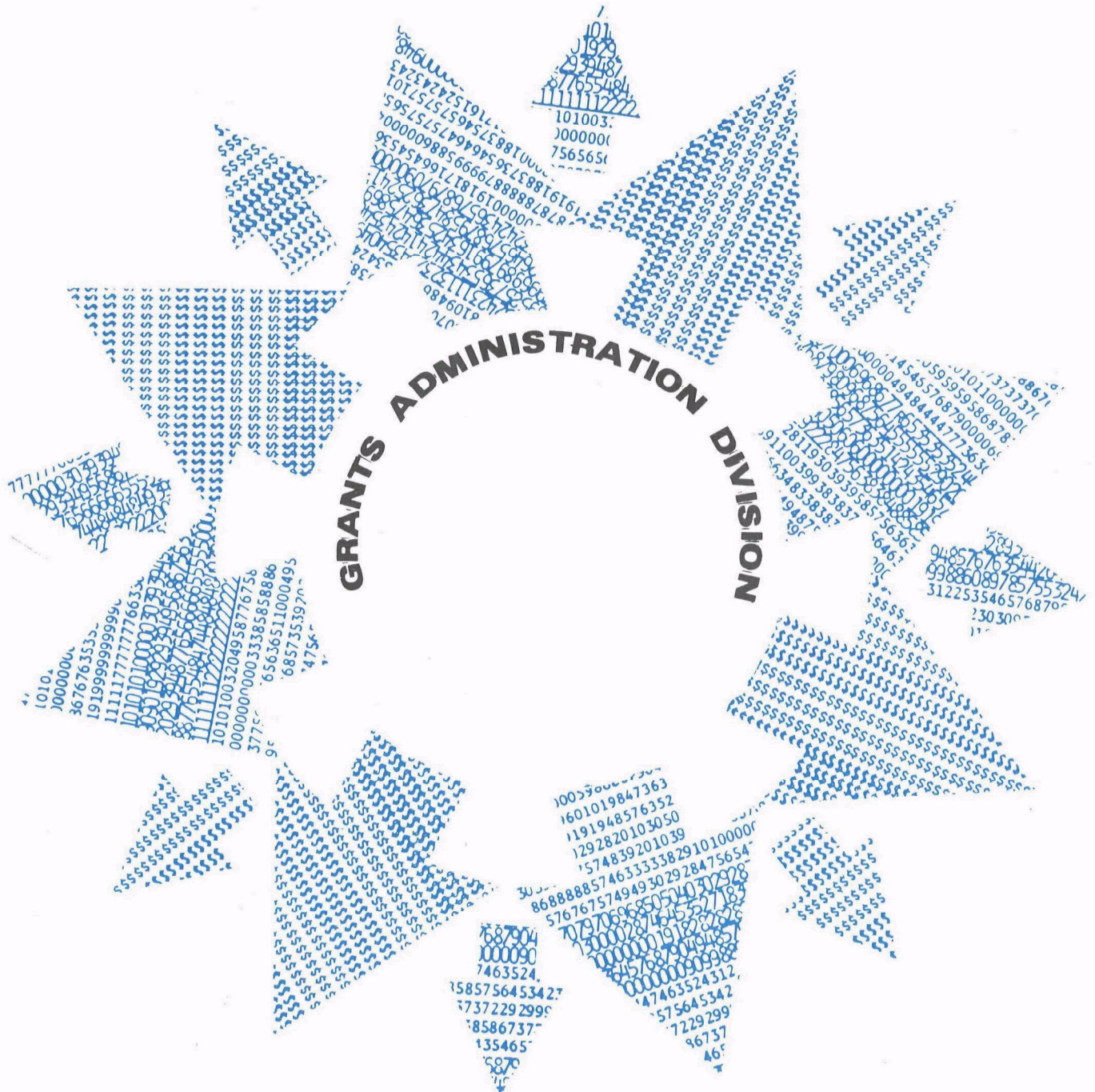

Grant Highlights

\$26 MILLION FUNDED IN OCTOBER

EPA approved 55 grants totaling \$26.6 million in October. Total grant dollars awarded during October decreased \$16.7 million when compared to October 1981. (\$26.6 million compared to \$43.3 million). (p. 7.)

45 STATES AND PUERTO RICO AWARDED STATE MANAGEMENT ASSISTANCE GRANTS

Since April 1980, EPA awarded State Management Assistance grants totaling \$314 million to 45 states and one territory (Puerto Rico). These grants provide funds for states to employ staff to administer segments of the WWT Construction Grants program delegated to them by EPA. (p. 17.)

35 STATES HAVE DELEGATED PERMIT PROGRAMS

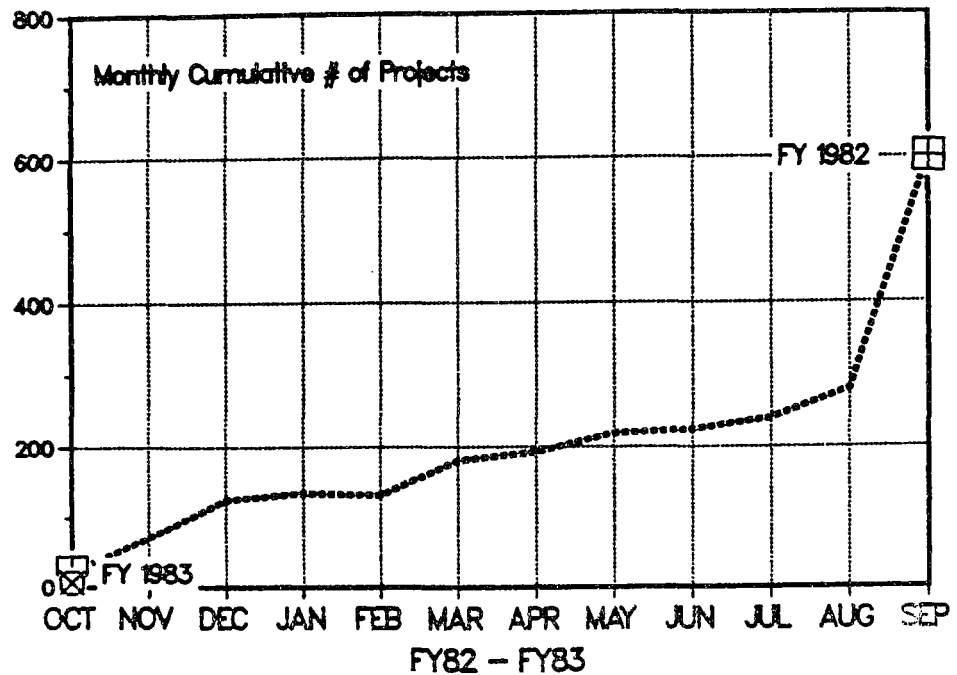
In accordance with Section 402(b) of the Clean Water Act, 35 states administer delegated permit programs limiting discharges into navigable waters within each state jurisdiction. (p. 18.)

NEW and CONTINUATION PROJECTS AWARDED

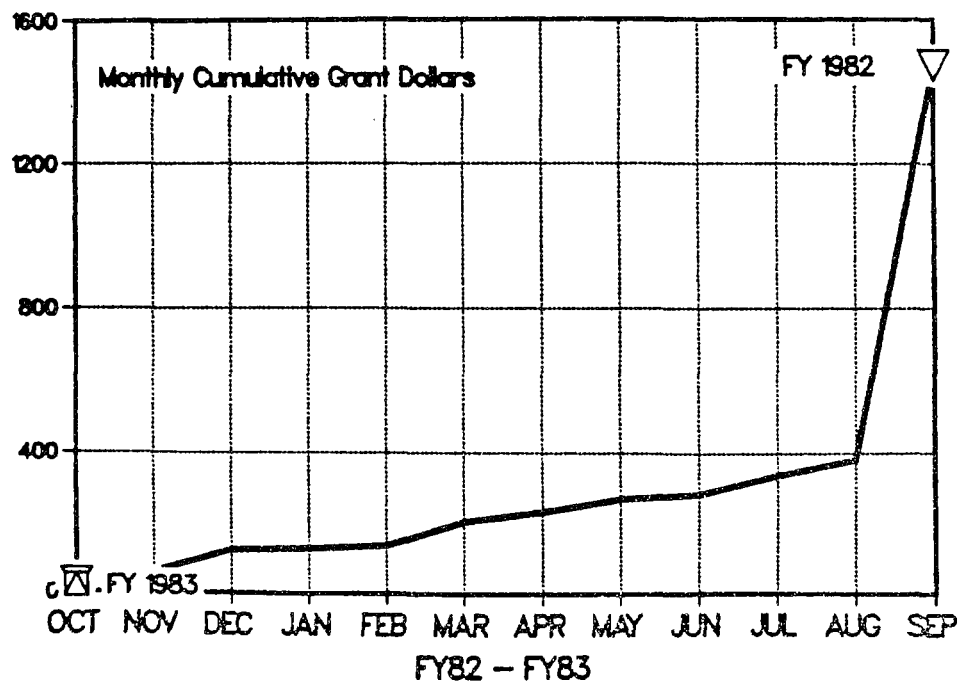
New and Continuation Number of Projects Awarded during FY82 & FY 83

New and Continuation Projects Grant Dollars Awarded during FY 82 & FY 83

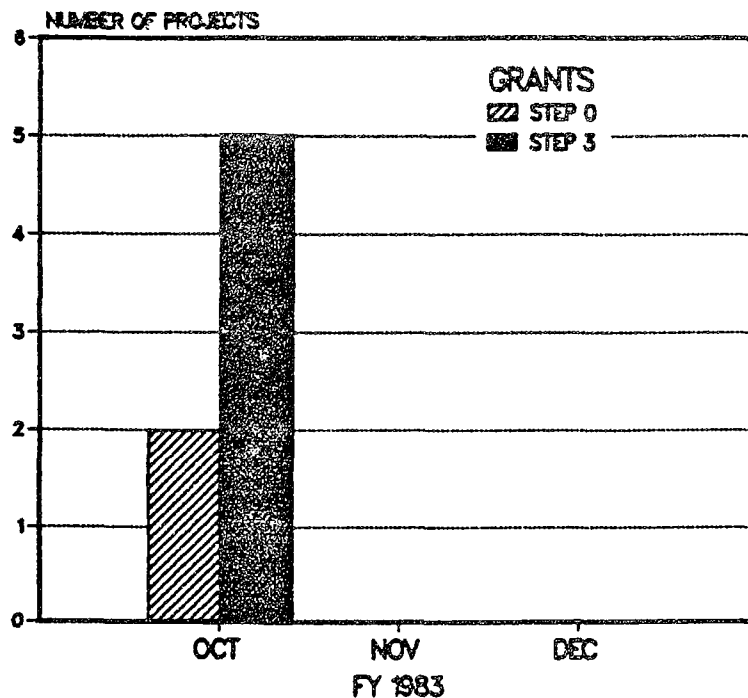

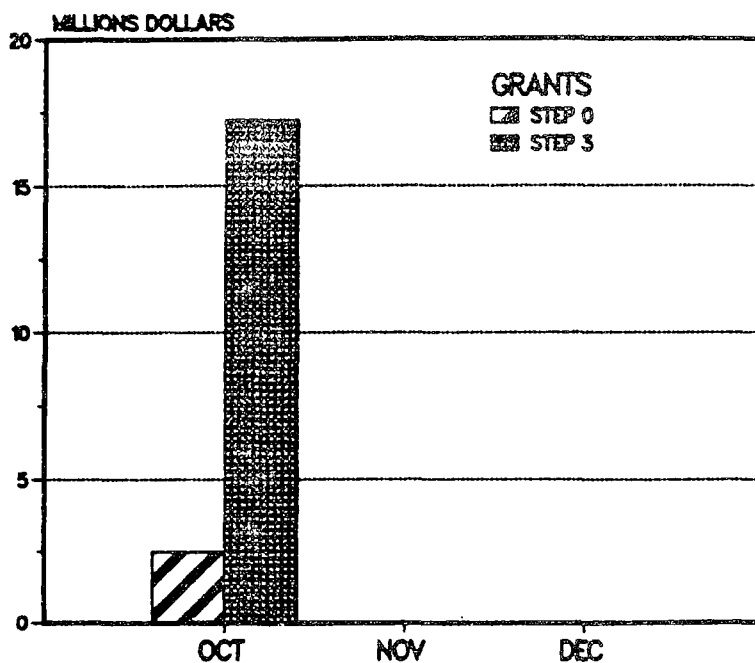

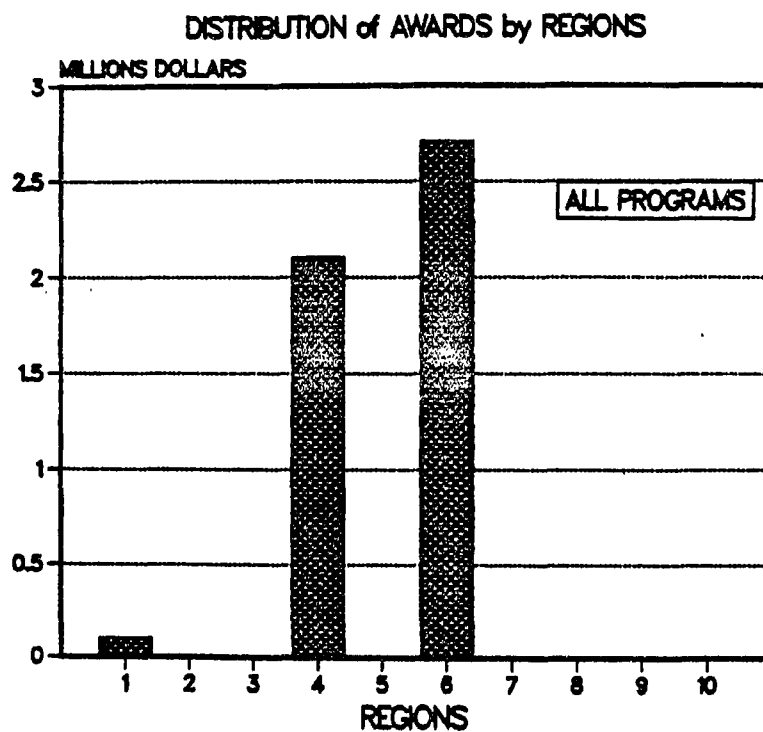

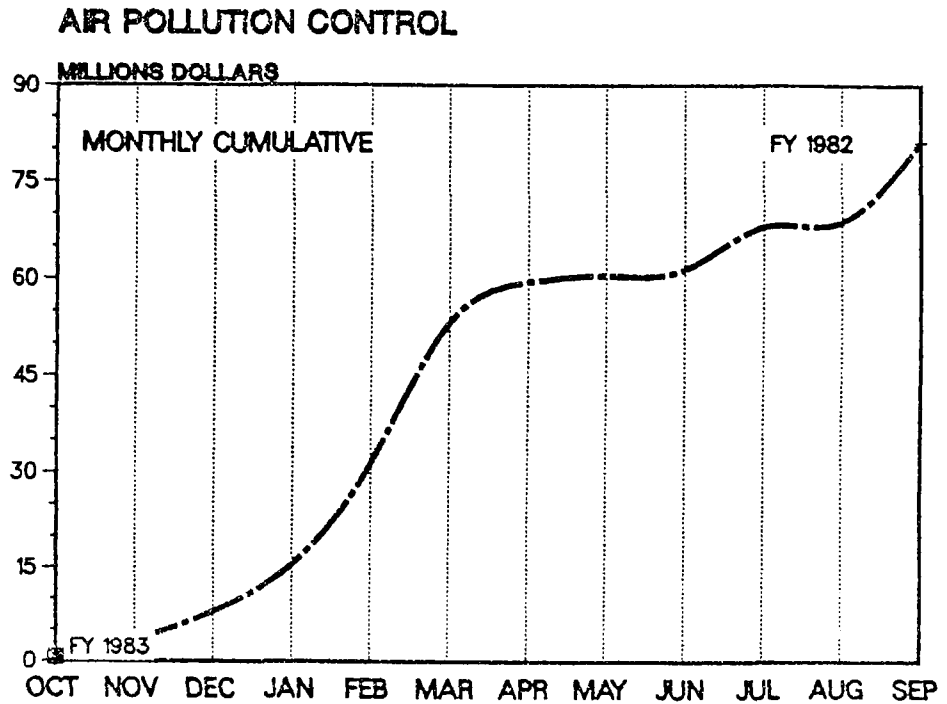
State and Local Assistance Programs (Excluding WWT Construction Grants)

Awards by Region

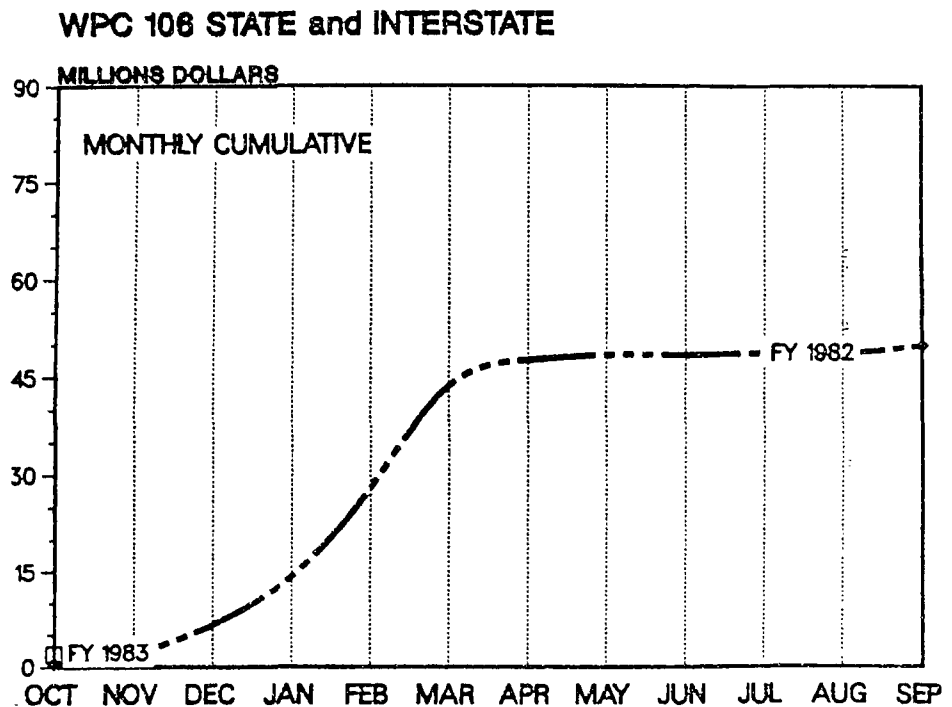


State and Local Assistance Program (Excluding WWT Construction Grants)

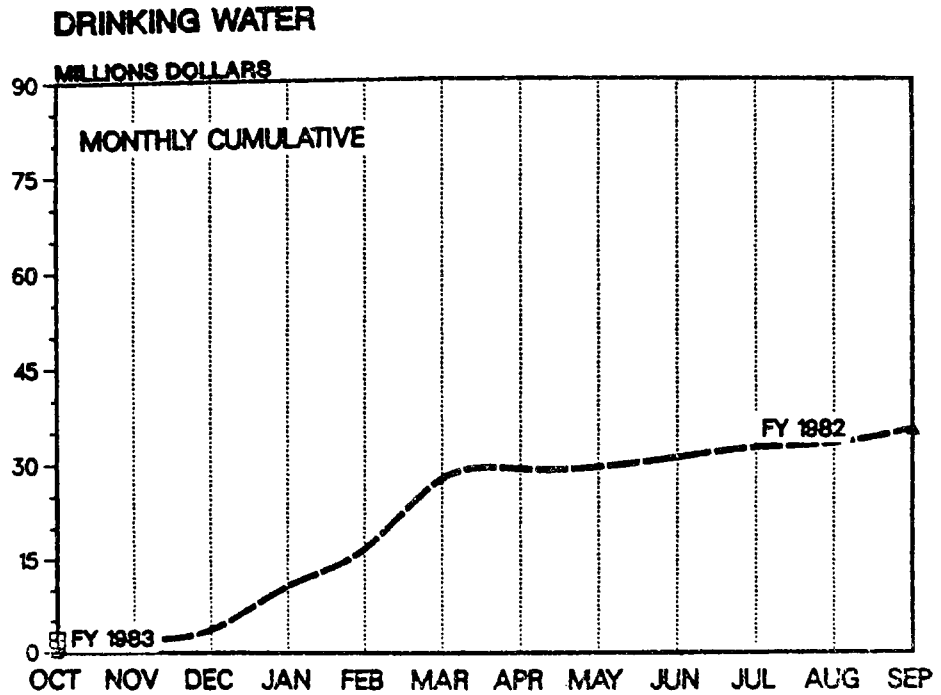

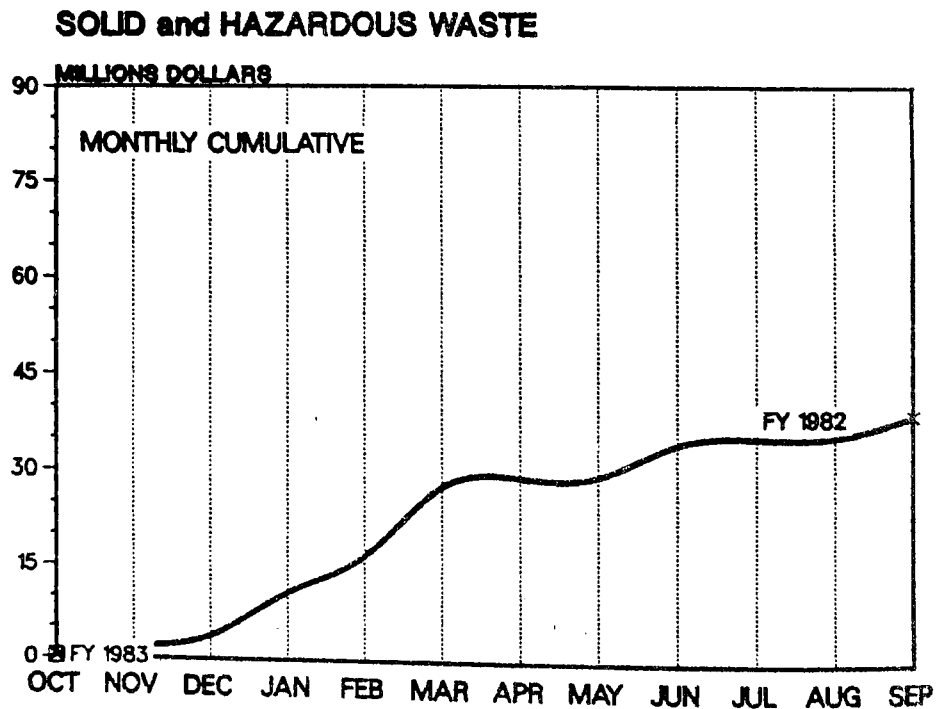
