THIS ARTICLE EXAMINES THE FINDINGS OF PROFESSOR H. VANDER EYCKEN'S AND MR. J. J. BOURDON'S PUBLIC OPINION SURVEY CONCERNING AIR POLLUTION IN BELGIUM. ALTHOUGH A MAJORITY OF RESPONDENTS REGISTERED THEIR SUPPORT FOR THE "POLLUTER PAYS PRINCIPLE" BY ADVOCATING THE ALLOCATION OF THE FINANCIAL BURDEN OF ANTI-POLLUTION MEASURES TO INDUSTRY, A COMPARABLE NUMBER STATED THAT THEY FAILED TO REALIZE THAT THEY, AS CONSUMERS AND TAXPAYERS, WOULD BEAR THE BULK OF SUCH COSTS. SINCE STATISTICS INDICATE THAT ONLY ONE FOURTH OF THE POPULATION IS NOW PREPARED TO MAKE THE NECESSARY SACRIFICES FOR A CLEANER ENVIRONMENT, THE POLLSTERS CONCLUDED THAT THE "POLLUTER PAYS PRINCIPLE" WOULD HAVE TO BE APPLIED WITH MODERATION UNTIL ADDITIONAL INFORMATION MAKES THE PUBLIC MORE RECEPTIVE TO THE CONCEPT OF FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY.

THIS NEWSPAPER ARTICLE REPORTS THAT THE BRAZILIAN MINISTRY OF INDUSTRY AND COMMERCE WILL MAKE THE CONTROL OF INDUSTRIAL POLLUTION ONE OF THE SPECIFIC FUNCTIONS OF ONE OF ITS SUBORDINATE ENTITIES, THE NATIONAL TECHNOLOGICAL INSTITUTE. THE INSTITUTE WILL CONCENTRATE ON FINDING TECHNOLOGICAL SOLUTIONS TO COMBAT POLLUTION CAUSED BY INDUSTRIES BOTH ON A PREVENTIVE BASIS AND IN INSTANCES IN WHICH STATE OR MUNICIPAL AUTHORITIES HAVE THREATENED TO CLOSE DOWN EXCESSIVELY POLLUTING INDUSTRIES. THE MINISTRY WILL ALSO CONCENTRATE ON RECYCLING OF INDUSTRIAL WASTES AND WILL ATTEMPT TO CONSIDER ENVIRONMENTAL FACTORS IN ALL NEW PROJECTS AND ACTIVITIES UNDER ITS JURISDICTION. CITING AUTOMOBILES AS THE MAJOR CAUSE OF POLLUTION, THE MINISTRY HAS CONSULTED WITH THE AUTOMOBILE INDUSTRY RECOMMENDING VEHICLE SAFETY AND POLLUTION CONTROL AS PRIORITY RESEARCH AREAS.

THIS AMENDMENT TO THE CANADIAN CLEAN AIR ACT CONCERNS AMBIENT AIR QUALITY STANDARDS FOR NITROGEN DIOXIDE. SCHEDULE I OF THE AMENDMENT DEFINES "DESIRABLE" AIR QUALITY AS CONTAINING 0-60 MICROGRAMS OF NITROGEN DIOXIDE PER CUBIC METER ANNUAL ARITHMETIC MEAN. "ACCEPTABLE" AIR QUALITY RELATIVE TO NITROGEN DIOXIDE CONSTITUTES 0-100 MICROGRAMS PER CUBIC METER ANNUAL ARITHMETIC MEAN, 0-200 MICROGRAMS PER CUBIC METER AVERAGE CONCENTRATION OVER A 24-HOUR PERIOD, OR 0-400 MICROGRAMS PER CUBIC METER AVERAGE CONCENTRATION OVER A ONE-HOUR PERIOD. THE AMENDMENT ALSO PRESCRIBES THE ACCEPTABLE METHODS OF MEASUREMENT OF NITROGEN DIOXIDE CONCENTRATIONS.

THIS NEWSPAPER ARTICLE REPRINTS A RESPONSE OF THE NATIONAL CEMENT INDUSTRY OF COSTA RICA TO THE CENTRAL GOVERNMENT SUMMARIZING THE MEASURES TAKEN BY THE INDUSTRY AND BY GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS TO ABATE THE AIR POLLUTION EMITTED BY THE NATIONAL CEMENT FACTORY IN EL GUARCO DE CARTAGO. AS A RESULT OF LOCAL PUBLIC OPINION AND AS DIRECTED BY THE COSTA RICAN MINISTER OF ECONOMY, INDUSTRY AND COMMERCE, THE INDUSTRY HAS DELINEATED POLLUTION ABATEMENT PROGRAMS WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE MINISTRIES OF ECONOMY, INDUSTRY AND COMMERCE; PUBLIC HEALTH; AND PUBLIC WORKS AND TRANSPORT. THIS NEWSPAPER ARTICLE REPORTS THAT THE NATIONAL COMMISSION AGAINST ENVIRONMENTAL POLLUTION OF THE DOMINICAN REPUBLIC, INVESTIGATING POLLUTION CHARGES LODGED AGAINST THE FALCONBRIDGE MINING COMPANY IN BONA0, HAS POINTED OUT THE LACK OF ENVIRONMENTAL LAWS AND ADEQUATE POLLUTION MONITORING SYSTEMS IN THE COUNTRY. THIS NEWSPAPER ARTICLE ANNOUNCES THAT A REGULATION WHICH BECAME EFFECTIVE JANUARY 23, 1975, IN THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY PROVIDES FOR GRADUAL REDUCTION OF SULFUR CONTENT IN FUEL OIL AND DIESEL PROPELLANT. THE REGULATION, ISSUED PURSUANT TO THE FEDERAL IMMISSIONS LAW, WHICH CAME INTO FORCE APRIL 1, 1974, REQUIRES REDUCTION OF SULFUR CONTENT TO 0.55 PERCENT FROM MAY 1, 1975, TO 0.50 PERCENT FROM MAY 1, 1976 AND TO 0.3 PERCENT FROM JANUARY 1, 1979. THIS WILL MEAN AN EFFECTIVE REDUCTION OF SULFUR IN EMISSIONS FROM HOME OIL FURNACES AND DIESEL MOTORS OF 40 PERCENT. THE FEDERAL MINISTER OF THE INTERIOR ALSO ANNOUNCED AT THIS TIME THAT THE FEDERAL DIET HAS APPROVED TWO OTHER REGULATIONS PURSUANT TO THE IMMISSIONS LAW. ONE CONCERNS ENVIRONMENTALLY HARMFUL INDUSTRIAL ESTABLISHMENTS, WHICH NEED PERMITS TO OPERATE, AND THE OTHER REQUIRES SUCH INDUSTRIES TO HIRE AN "IMMISSIONS OFFICIAL."

THIS ARTICLE DISCUSSES A STUDY ENTITLED "SYSTEM ANALYSIS: DESULPHURIZATION PROCESSES," PREPARED BY A WORK GROUP OF EXPERTS FOR THE FEDERAL MINISTRY OF RESEARCH AND TECHNOLOGY IN THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY, AND RELEASED IN BONN JANUARY 27. THE RESEARCH MINISTER NOTED ON THIS OCCASION THAT THE MINISTRY WILL EXPLORE WITH OTHER FEDERAL AND STATE AGENCIES, AS WELL AS WITH INDUSTRY, TO WHAT EXTENT PUBLIC FUNDS MUST BE MADE AVAILABLE IN EXCESS OF PREVIOUS LEVELS TO PROTECT THE ENVIRONMENT WHILE ENSURING AN ADEQUATE ENERGY SUPPLY THROUGH THE USE OF FOSSIL FUELS. OF IMPORTANCE ARE DESULPHURIZATION PROCESSES FOR HEAVY HEATING OILS, BITUMINOUS COAL AND FLUE GASES. A MAJOR PORTION OF THE STUDY TREATS DESULPHURIZATION PROCESSES FOR FLUE GASES AT TEN COAL-FIRED POWER PLANTS OF 6000 MEGAWATT CAPACITY EACH PLANNED TO MEET RISING ENERGY NEEDS. ABOUT 500 MILLION MARKS INITIAL INVESTMENT AND 240 MILLION MARKS YEARLY IN OPERATING COSTS WOULD BE REQUIRED TO REDUCE SULPHUR DIOXIDE EMISSIONS AROUND 2.5 PERCENT IN THESE PLANTS.

THIS NEWSPAPER ARTICLE REPORTS THAT THE JAPANESE ENVIRONMENT AGENCY WILL PROMULGATE, ON APRIL 15, REVISED REGULATIONS TO THE CLEAN AIR ACT OF 1968, WHICH REQUIRE FACTORIES IN 67 OUT OF 99 INDUSTRIAL AREAS TO FURTHER REDUCE SULFUR OXIDE EMISSIONS BY 25 PERCENT. THIS REPRESENTS ANOTHER STEP TOWARD ACHIEVING THE EVENTUAL GOAL OF REDUCING SULFUR OXIDE EMISSIONS TO .04 PPM BY MARCH 1978. IF THE NEW REGULATIONS ARE OBSERVED, THE NATIONAL AVERAGE OF SULFUR OXIDE EMISSIONS WILL BE REDUCED BY 19.4 PERCENT FROM PRESENT LEVELS. FACTORIES MUST MODIFY THEIR OPERATIONS TO MEET THE NEW REQUIREMENTS WITHIN THREE MONTHS OF APRIL 15. VIOLATORS WILL BE LIABLE TO SIX-MONTH PRISON TERMS OR FINES OF UP TO 100,000 YEN. ENVIRONMENT AGENCY OFFICIALS PLAN TO MEET THE TARGET STANDARD OF .04 PPM OF SULFUR OXIDES BY TIGHTENING EXISTING STANDARDS TWICE A YEAR.

THIS NEWSPAPER ARTICLE DISCUSSES THE MOST RECENT DEVELOPMENTS IN JAPAN CONCERNING AUTOMOBILE EMISSION CONTROLS. THE 1975 EMISSION CONTROL STANDARDS NOW REQUIRE AUTO MAKERS TO CONSIDERABLY REDUCE EXHAUST EMISSIONS ON NEW MODEL CARS. NEW CARS OF OLD MODELS MUST COMPLY WITH THE SAME STANDARDS BY DECEMBER 1, 1975. THE ENVIRONMENT AGENCY IS ALSO WORKING TO REGULATE EMISSIONS OF OTHER TYPES OF VEHICLES, AND IS CONSIDERING THE POSSIBILITY OF SETTING A LIMIT ON THE TOTAL NUMBER OF CAR OWNERS. A NATIONAL POLICE AGENCY CAMPAIGN ALREADY PLANS TO CUT THE NUMBER OF CARS IN LARGE CITIES BY 10 PERCENT. ALTHOUGH SOME CONCESSIONS HAVE BEEN MADE TO THE JAPANESE AUTO INDUSTRY, THE NEW EMISSION CONTROL STANDARDS ARE, NEVERTHELESS, THE MOST STRINGENT IN THE WORLD. HOWEVER, THE TRANSPORT MINISTRY STATES THAT IT WILL TAKE 10 YEARS BEFORE ALL CARS IN JAPAN ARE OF THE LOW POLLUTION TYPE AND THAT IT WILL BE AT LEAST TWO OR THREE YEARS BEFORE THE EFFECTS OF THE PRESENT STANDARDS BECOME APPARENT.

EXPERTS OF WHO RECOGNIZE THESE REGULATIONS ALONG WITH SIMILAR LEGISLATION AS AMONG THE MOST COMPREHENSIVE IN EUROPE. HOWEVER, THE ENFORCEMENT OF THESE LAWS STILL DEPENDS ON THE AVAILABLE FINANCIAL RESOURCES. STATISTICS INDICATE THAT AIR POLLUTION CONTROL WILL REQUIRE ANNUALLY EIGHT BILLION PESETAS WHICH REPRESENT THREE PERCENT OF TOTAL INDUSTRIAL INVESTMENTS. THIS COST AS PASSED ON TO THE CONSUMER WILL REDUCE CONSUMER BUYING POWER BY 1.2 PERCENT.

ALSO, AFTER ANY NOISE-PRODUCING ACTIVITY HAS BEEN DECLARED A PUBLIC NUISANCE, THE NEW ACT PERMITS THE ACTIVITY IN QUESTION TO CONTINUE DURING A 20-DAY APPEAL PERIOD. ANOTHER PROBLEM LIES IN THE FACT THAT THE ACT DEALS ONLY WITH EXISTING NOISE DISTURBANCES AND NOT WITH THE PREVENTION OF NOISE. THE ARTICLE ALSO CITES EXAMPLES OF NOISE PREVENTION MEASURES WHICH HAVE BEEN TAKEN AS A RESULT OF THE "NOISE INSULATION REGULATIONS, 1973" AND THE DEPARTMENT OF THE ENVIRONMENT CIRCULAR "PLANNING AND NOISE" OF 1973.

THIS ARTICLE, CONCERNING THE DEFICIENCIES OF WATER POLLUTION LEGISLATION IN THE KAZAKH SSR, ESPECIALLY WITH REGARD TO PENAL PROVISIONS, CITES NATIONAL WATER POLLUTION CONTROL LEGISLATION OF THE USSR AS WELL AS THAT OF THE KAZAKH REPUBLIC. IT IS NOTED THAT THE "BASES OF WATER LEGISLATION OF THE USSR AND FEDERATED REPUBLICS" PROVIDES FOR PENAL ACTION AGAINST DANGEROUS VIOLATIONS OF WATER PROTECTION REGULATIONS. AMONG THE REGULATIONS OF THE KAZAKH WATER CODE IS THE PROHIBITION OF THE OPERATION OF INDUSTRIAL PLANTS NOT EQUIPPED WITH PURIFICATION FACILITIES. ALSO CITED ARE THE "REGULATIONS ON THE PROTECTION OF FISH RESOURCES AND ON FISHING IN WATERS OF THE USSR," WHICH PROHIBIT LAND DISPOSAL OF SEWAGE BY IRRIGATION METHODS WITHOUT TAKING FISH-PROTECTION MEASURES AND BLASTING OPERATIONS WHICH WOULD DESTROY SPAWNING AREAS OF FISH. SUCH ACTIVITIES ARE NOT PROHIBITED BY KAZAKH LEGISLATION.
