


We have a beautiful environment in New England...









Air pollution damages our lungs. It can kill trees and animals. It can also kill people...



Smog hurts our eyes and makes it hard to breathe.


Water pollution can cause beaches to be closed.








Untreated sewage and polluted storm drains poison our waters. Boats sometimes flush waste into the water. Oil spills can do great damage on seashores.

Pollution can affect the air, water, and the land. It can offend our eyes and noses, and breed disease.




So, if we are to clean up our world, we must all pitch in...



Never throw trash on the ground - put it in the nearest trash can. We can help clean up beaches and the countryside.


