HOW TO USE YOUR DIRECTORY

Agency addresses are listed under the State in which they are located, and States are listed alphabetically within the ten Federal Regions. A map is displayed with each State indicating areas undergoing areawide water quality management planning. The agency listing presents the State water quality management agency first, followed by the State's contacts. Local agencies are indented five spaces and are generally listed in order of designation. To the right of the agency address is the date and amount of the grant award and counties included in the planning.

We have provided a thumb index to facilitate finding the Regions, a table of contents alphabetized by State, a general table of contents and an agency table of contents.

THUMB INDEX: to use the thumb index, bend pamphlet back with your right hand and find the black bar that lines up with the symbol of the Region you are seeking.

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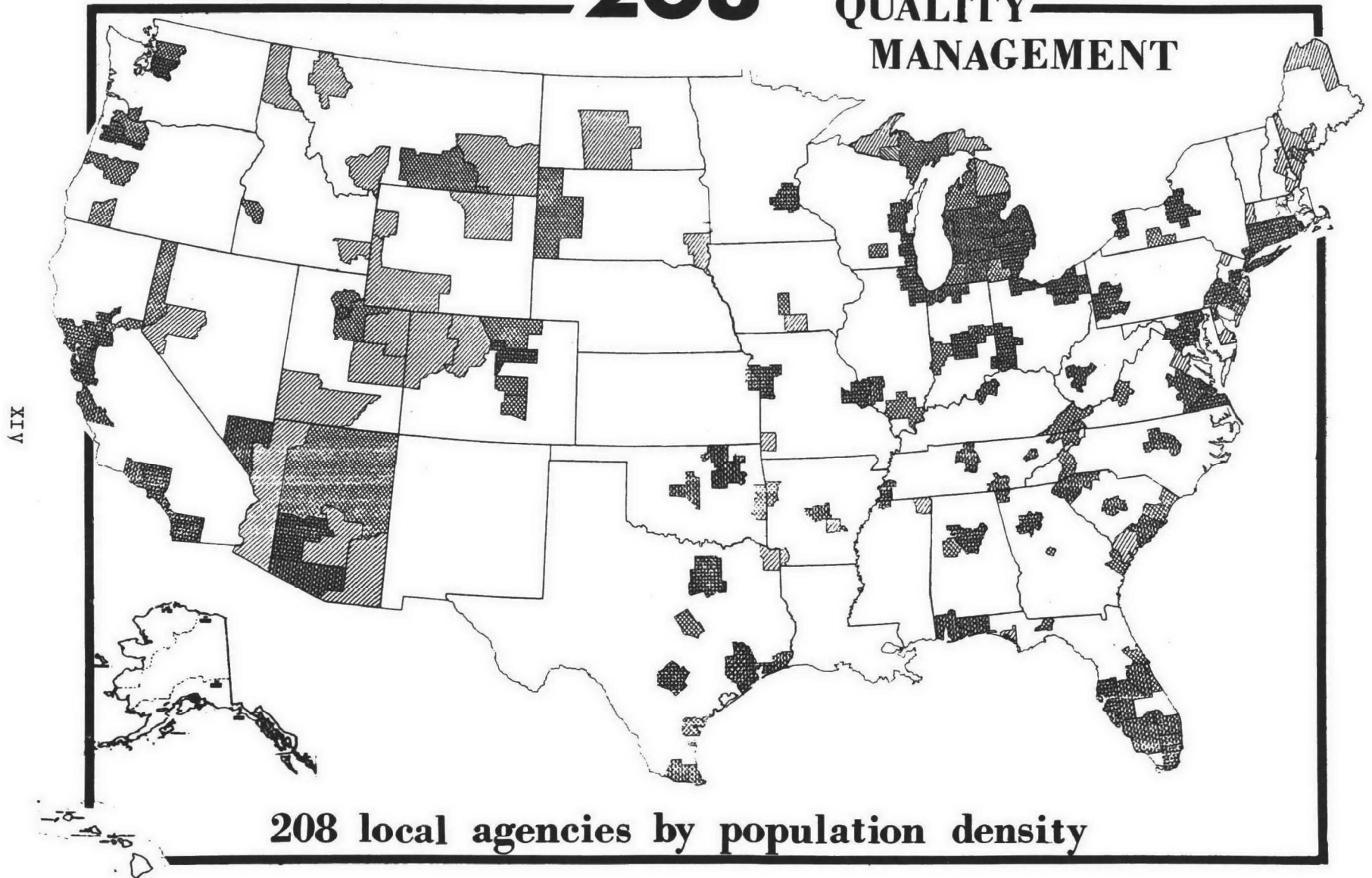

WASHINGTON, D.C.-MD.-VA., STANDARD METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA

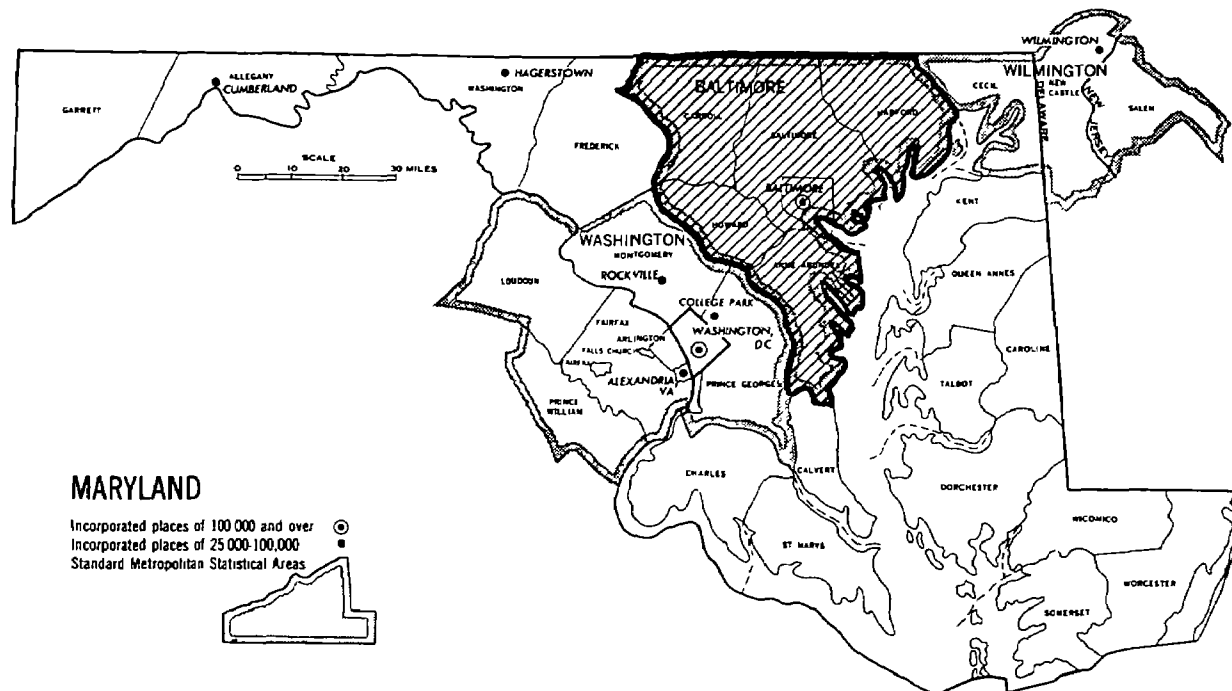
