Clean thoroughly the places where pesticide residues can be found.



Bathe with shampoo and soap directly after work.



Remove work boots before entering the house.



Wash your work clothes separately from the family's clothes.



Prevent insects from entering your home by sealing cracks and keeping the house clean and dry.



Have the whole family wash their hands before eating, drinking, or going to the bathroom.



Close windows, turn off ventilators, and cover outside equipment when pesticides are being sprayed near your house.



Keep all cleaning and pesticide products outside of children's reach.



Do not bring agricultural pesticides home.
