# How to Add a Biointermediate Production Facility to a Registered Company

This job aid is designed to provide a high-level overview of the process for adding a Biointermediate Production Facility to a registered company in OTAQREG so that you can start using the new functionality as quickly as possible.


### Before you begin:

- 1. You must have a Central Data Exchange (CDX) account
- 2. You must be logged into the CDX OTAQREG program service
- 3. You must be a delegated user with editing privileges for a registered company in OTAQREG



- 1. Click the Company ID
- 2. Select Edit Program Types and Activities



- 3. Answer NO to question "Are you required to submit Engineering Reviews (ER) via ER
  Webform and/or documents via DCFuels in order to register your company activities?" to reveal additional Program Type and Business Activities questions.
  - NOTE: This question may not appear, depending on the Program Type and Business Activities that are currently active on your company's registration.
- 4. Answer YES to question "Do you produce, import, export or otherwise handle Renewable Fuels or Biointermediate Products as defined under the Renewable Fuel Standard Program?"
- 5. Answer YES for business activity
